The seven trumpet judgment

Revelation 8:1-5 **Seventh Seal: Prelude to the Seven Trumpets**

8 ¹When He opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. ²And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets. ³Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer *it* with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. ⁴And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand. ⁵Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw *it* to the earth. And there were noises, thundering's, lightning's, and an earthquake.

- A. The breaking of the seventh seal: Remember what we have just seen, God just handed Jesus the great book of destiny, the book that tells about the end of the world. The first four seals showed us the four horsemen of the apocalypse (the revelation, the unveiling). The fifth seal showed us the martyrs who were killed for the word's sake. The sixth seal showed us the rumblings of God's judgment, it simply says the great day of His wrath has come. Now we come to the seventh seal.

Matthew 24:1-28 **Jesus Predicts the Destruction of the Temple**

24 ¹Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. ²And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not *one* stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down."

The Signs of the Times and the End of the Age

³Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And what *will be* the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?" ⁴And Jesus answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you. ⁵For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many. ⁶And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for ^[a]all *these things* must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

⁷ For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, ^[b]pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. ⁸ All these *are* the beginning of sorrows. ⁹ “Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name’s sake. ¹⁰ And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. ¹¹ Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. ¹² And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. ¹³ But he who endures to the end shall be saved. ¹⁴ And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

The Great Tribulation

¹⁵ “Therefore when you see the ‘abomination of desolation,’ spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place” (whoever reads, let him understand), ¹⁶ “then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ¹⁷ Let him who is on the housetop not go down to take anything out of his house. ¹⁸ And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. ¹⁹ But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! ²⁰ And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath. ²¹ For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. ²² And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the ^[c]elect’s sake those days will be shortened. ²³ “Then if anyone says to you, ‘Look, here *is* the Christ!’ or ‘There!’ do not believe *it*. ²⁴ For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ²⁵ See, I have told you beforehand. ²⁶ “Therefore if they say to you, ‘Look, He is in the desert!’ do not go out; *or* ‘Look, *He is* in the inner rooms!’ do not believe *it*. ²⁷ For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. ²⁸ For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.

1. The seventh seal has been broken: There is a picture of shattering silence, note the silence lasts about a half hour. I believe everyone is silent because they see what is about to happen.

Isaiah 49:10 ¹⁰Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times *things* that are not *yet* done, Saying, ‘My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,’

Amos 5:13 ¹³Therefore the prudent keep silent at that time, For it *is* an evil time.

2. Trumpet judgments: When God hands the seven trumpets to the seven angels. Trumpets symbolize God's intervention into human history. God is about to go against the godless and evil society. Very important note God does not move against his sealed people

Revelation 9:4 They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth, or any green thing, or any tree, but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads.

Revelation 16:2 So the first went and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and a ^[a]foul and loathsome sore came upon the men who had the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.

This is a quote from George Ladd: The wrath of God is not merely judicial: It always embodies a merciful purpose, it's designed to drive men to their knees before it is too late.

William Barclay: It can sound the alarm. It can awaken from danger. And God is always sounding the alarm in the ears of men. It can be the fanfare which announces royalty. It is a fitting symbol to express the invasion of time by the King of eternity. It can be a summons to battle. And God is always summoning His people to take sides in the strife of truth and falsehood and to become a soldier of the King of Kings.

The second instrument of judgment is the prayers of all the saints and the believers, some were in heaven and some were still on the earth. All had suffered and some were still suffering the savage persecution of the antichrist and his government, remember how savage this will be: literally millions; numberless; multitudes will be killed. Believers will be crying out to God day and night and God hears them and answers their prayers. All who have rebelled against Jesus Christ-rejected, denied, cursed, ignored, neglected, disobeyed and have not believed shall be judged. These are some promises of God.

Keep Asking, Seeking, Knocking: Luke 11:9 ⁹“So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

John 15:7 ⁷ If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you^[a] will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

1 John 3:22 ²²And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.

Psalms 91:15 He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him.

Isaiah 65:24 “It shall come to pass, That before they call, I will answer; And while they are still speaking, I will hear.

Jeremiah 33:3 ‘Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and ^[a]mighty things, which you do not know.’

Zechariah 13:9 I will bring the *one-third* through the fire, Will refine them as silver is refined, And test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, And I will answer them. I will say, ‘This *is* My people’; And each one will say, ‘The LORD *is* my God.’ ”

3. Judgment: **Revelation 8:5** Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw *it* to the earth. And there were noises, thunderings, lightnings, and an earthquake.

The angel takes fire from the altar and mixes it with prayers of the saints who have been persecuted. Why? The time is coming when God will judge this godless society on earth, He is ready to avenge His people, that's us. There will be thundering storms and violent earthquakes. This is the beginning of the great tribulation.

Matthew 11:22 ²² But I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in the Day of Judgment than for you.

Mark 6:11 And ^[a]whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet as a testimony against them. ^[b]Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!”

Jude 1:14-15 Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, “Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, ¹⁵ to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him.”

Romans 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who ^[a]suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

Psalms 96:12-13 Let the field be joyful, and all that *is* in it. Then all the trees of the woods will rejoice ¹³ before the LORD. For He is coming, for He is coming to judge the earth. He shall judge the world with righteousness, And the peoples with His truth.
