The Trumpet Judgments

Revelation 8:6-12 ⁶ So the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

First Trumpet: Vegetation Struck

⁷ The first angel sounded: And hail and fire followed, mingled with blood, and they were thrown to the ^[a]earth. And a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.

Second Trumpet: The Seas Struck

⁸ Then the second angel sounded: And *something* like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood. ⁹ And a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

Third Trumpet: The Waters Struck

¹⁰ Then the third angel sounded: And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. ¹¹ The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.

Fourth Trumpet: The Heavens Struck

¹² Then the fourth angel sounded: And a third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them were darkened. A third of the day ^[b]did not shine, and likewise the night.

The blast of the first four trumpets:

1. There will be the blast of the first four trumpets, that of a fierce storm that will be terrifying to anyone who is left behind. The laws of nature will be swaying: enormous and violent disturbances will be taking place all throughout the universe.

Revelation 6:12-14 ¹²I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and ^[a]behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the ^[b]moon became like blood. ¹³And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, as a fig tree drops its late figs when it is shaken by a mighty wind. ¹⁴Then the sky ^[c]receded as a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island was moved out of its place.

These cosmic disturbances will cause utter chaos on the earth. The storms will destroy crops and food supply for both man and animal. One third of the vegetation will be destroyed in judgment. The end of the world is at hand. God will begin to judge the ungodly and the evil of the earth. It will be time for people to know that God truly is who He says He is.

Exodus 9:23-24 And Moses stretched out his rod toward heaven; and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and fire darted to the ground. And the LORD rained hail on the land of Egypt. ²⁴So there was hail, and fire mingled with the hail, so very heavy that there was none like it in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation.

The storms will be similar to the storms in Joshua:

Joshua 10:11 And it happened, as they fled before Israel *and* were on the descent of Beth Horon, that the LORD cast down large hailstones from heaven on them as far as Azekah, and they died. *There were* more who died from the hailstones than the children of Israel killed with the sword.

2. The second trumpet; Volcanic explosions that will cast rocks as big as mountains, it will hit the sea and the sea will turn to blood sea life will die a third of the ships will be destroyed.

Hosea 4:1-3 Hear the word of the LORD, You children of Israel, For the LORD *brings* a charge^[a] against the inhabitants of the land: “There is no truth or mercy Or knowledge of God in the land.² *By* swearing and lying, Killing and stealing and committing adultery, They break all restraint, With bloodshed^[b] upon bloodshed. Therefore the land will mourn; And everyone who dwells there will waste away With the beasts of the field And the birds of the air; Even the fish of the sea will be taken away.

Isaiah 2 ¹The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem. ²Now it shall come to pass in the latter days *That* the mountain of the LORD’s house Shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; And all nations shall flow to it. ³ Many people shall come and say, “Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, To the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths. ”For out of Zion shall go forth the law ,And the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.⁴ He shall judge between the nations ,And rebuke many people; They shall beat their swords into plowshares, And their spears into pruning^[a] hooks; Nation shall not lift up sword against nation, Neither shall they learn war anymore **The Day of the LORD** ⁵O house of Jacob, come and let us walk In the light of the LORD. ⁶ For You have forsaken Your people, the house of Jacob, Because they are filled with eastern ways; They *are* soothsayers like the Philistines, And they^[b] are pleased with the children of foreigners.⁷ Their land is also full of silver and gold, And there is no end to their treasures; Their land is also full of horses, And there is no end to their chariots.⁸ Their land is also full of idols; They worship the work of their own hands, That which their own fingers have made. ⁹ People bow down, And each man humbles himself; Therefore do not forgive them.¹⁰ Enter into the rock, and hide in the dust, From the terror of the LORD And the glory of His majesty.¹¹ The^[c] lofty looks of man shall be humbled, The haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, And the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. ¹² For the day of the LORD of hosts *Shall come* upon everything proud and lofty, Upon everything lifted up—And it shall be brought low— ¹³ Upon all the cedars of Lebanon *that are* high and lifted up, And upon all the oaks of Bashan

¹⁴ Upon all the high mountains, And upon all the hills *that are* lifted up;¹⁵ Upon every high tower, And upon every fortified wall;¹⁶ Upon all the ships of Tarshish, And upon all the beautiful sloops.¹⁷ The ^[d]loftiness of man shall be bowed down, And the haughtiness of men shall be brought low; The LORD alone will be exalted in that day,¹⁸ But the idols ^[e]He shall utterly abolish.¹⁹ They shall go into the holes of the rocks, And into the caves of the ^[f]earth, From the terror of the LORD And the glory of His majesty, When He arises to shake the earth mightily.²⁰ In that day a man will cast away his idols of silver And his idols of gold, Which they made, *each* for himself to worship, To the moles and bats,²¹ To go into the clefts of the rocks, And into the crags of the rugged rocks, From the terror of the LORD And the glory of His majesty, When He arises to shake the earth mightily.²² Sever^[g] yourselves from such a man, Whose breath *is* in his nostrils For ^[h]of what account is he?

Zephaniah 1:2-3 I will ^[a]utterly consume everything From the face of the land, "Says the LORD; ³ "I will consume man and beast; I will consume the birds of the heavens, The fish of the sea, And the ^[b]stumbling blocks along with the wicked. I will cut off man from the face of the ^[c]land, "Says the LORD.

3. The third trumpet: The meteor mass (wormwood) or called apophis- in the Greek was an Egyptian god or spirit of evil and destruction. The God of darkness.

Revelation 8:11 ¹¹ The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.

When this meteor hits the earth, there will be a shortage of water. People will be thirsty and have no water to drink. This meteor is the size of four football fields and would do enough damage as a hundred nuclear weapons. I believe that God will destroy the earth, not man.

Jeremiah 9:13-15 ¹³ And the LORD said, “Because they have forsaken My law which I set before them, and have not obeyed My voice, nor walked according to it, ¹⁴ but they have walked according to the ^[a]dictates of their own hearts and after the Baals, which their fathers taught them,” ¹⁵ therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: “Behold, I will feed them, this people, with wormwood, and give them ^[b]water of gall to drink.

Deuteronomy 29:18 ¹⁸ so that there may not be among you man or woman or family or tribe, whose heart turns away today from the LORD our God, to go *and* serve the gods of these nations, and that there may not be among you a root bearing bitterness or wormwood;

Amos 5:6-7 ⁶Seek the LORD and live, Lest He break out like fire *in* the house of Joseph, And devour *it*, With no one to quench *it* in Bethel—⁷ You who turn justice to wormwood, And lay righteousness to rest in the earth!”

4. The fourth trumpet: There will be a astronomical eclipse

Joel 2:10 The earth quakes before them, The heavens tremble; The sun and moon grow dark, And the stars diminish their brightness.

Amos 8:9 “And it shall come to pass on that day,” says the Lord GOD, “That I will make the sun go down at noon, And I will darken the earth in ^[a]broad daylight; Whatever this means things will be bad. No sunlight means it will get very cold and unbearable.

The picture of this is that God has had enough.

Luke 21:25-28 “And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring; ²⁶ men’s hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. ²⁷ Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. ²⁸ Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near.”
